

# BB/SAA QUICK INFORMATION GUIDE

## No Alcohol Policy

City of Bellevue Ordinance 3.43.250 states that it is unlawful for any person to use or possess an alcoholic beverage (including unopened alcoholic beverage containers) in a park. This ordinance also applies to School District property and King County facilities.

## Practice Scheduling

Teams may not use ball fields unless they are reserved in advance. Practice fields may be scheduled (minimum 5 days in advance) through Bellevue Parks at [http://www.bellevuewa.gov/ballfield\\_reservations.htm](http://www.bellevuewa.gov/ballfield_reservations.htm). Marymoor fields practice time may be scheduled (between one and two weeks in advance only) through King County Parks by calling 206-205-3661 Mondays and Tuesdays from 10 am - 2 pm.

## Lights Policy/Field Times

Start times for weeknight games scheduled at Bellevue and Marymoor fields will **typically** be 6 pm and 8:30 pm (**some exceptions at Marymoor fields**). Ball field lights will turn on at dusk. **Hidden Valley #1 lights will turn off at 11:00 pm** – please complete your games on time! Ball field lights at Marymoor will go off at 11:15 pm.

If there are problems with the field (no lights, sprinklers on, etc.) call:

**Bellevue Field Problems – 425-452-6855** (answering service)

**Marymoor Field Problems – 206-669-8931** (**on-site crew weekdays until 9 pm**)

**Marymoor Lighting Failure/Trouble – 206-225-8936**

During non-school hours (evenings and weekends), the parking lot at the Sammamish High School will be locked immediately following the conclusion of the last scheduled game.

## Infield Maintenance (Lining & Dragging):

The Parks Departments are responsible for lining and dragging infields prior to 6 pm on weekdays and before the 9 am and 3:30 pm games on weekends (for league play). If infield maintenance is not done please indicate this when reporting scores.

## Rainouts & Field Closure Information

During periods of inclement weather, field closures are determined by the Parks Departments. Closures may also result from poor or unsafe playing conditions and/or damage that would require excessive repair work.

**Bellevue Parks - 425-452-4860** (after 3 pm weekdays and after 7 am & noon on weekends).

**Marymoor Park - 206-205-3892** (after 3 pm weekdays and after 8:00 am weekends).

If fields are not closed by the Parks Departments, the umpire will decide rainouts at game time.

## Rescheduling Rainouts

Due to time constraints and limited field availability, all games that are rained out will be rescheduled by BB/SAA. You will receive e-mail notification of the date, time, and field for your rescheduled games.

## Umpire No-Shows

**USSSA Umpire Digital Pager - 206-344-9519**. Input the number of the phone you are calling from and hang up. The USSSA Umpire Assigner should call you right back.

## Score Reporting

All game scores, rainouts, and cancellations must be reported at the website ([www.BBSAA.org](http://www.BBSAA.org)) by the **winning** team **within 48 hours** of the completion of the game.

## Forfeits

Managers – it is your responsibility to field a team! Forfeits are not fair to the opposing team, or to your team members who show up to play. Any team forfeiting a game will be charged at least a \$50.00 service charge per game. More than three (3) forfeits during the season may result in that team's expulsion from BB/SAA's next season of softball play.

## Playoffs

Generally, the top 4 teams from each division will earn a playoff berth. Playoffs for both 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Seasons will begin after the end of **each** Season.
